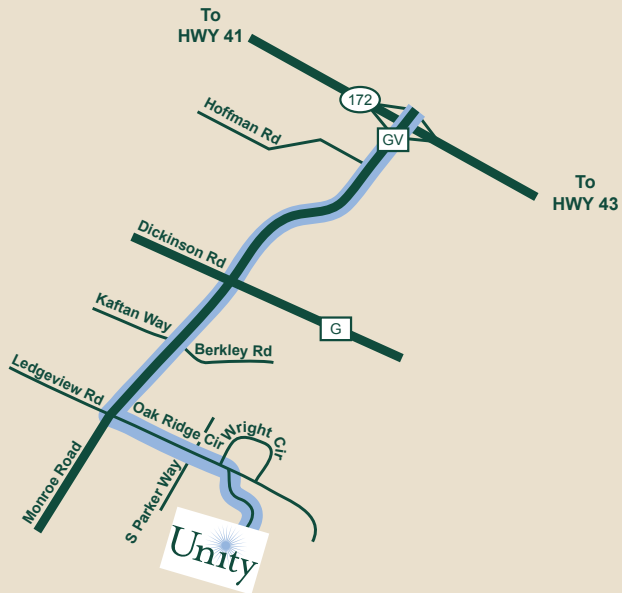


## About Unity

## Unity's Jack and Engrid Meng Residence

Our hospice residence is situated on a beautiful, 34-acre property in De Pere, Wisconsin, surrounded by tranquil gardens, ponds and cedar woods. All patients enjoy private rooms in a peaceful, home-like setting with access to around-the-clock comfort and care provided by Unity's skilled staff.

The Jack and Engrid Meng Residence gives patients a place to feel at home, enjoy togetherness with loved ones and find serenity in the final days of life. Features include:

- 12 private, fully-furnished rooms each with personal bathroom and shower, TV/DVD, telephone, linens and towels, and individual temperature controls for heating and cooling
- Full kitchen
- Living room, reflection room and two family rooms, including a special children's area, available to patients and guests
- Ponds, gardens and walking path
- Handicap-accessible building

Unity's commitment to quality care allows patients and their loved ones to focus on personal connections and matters important to them, while Unity handles the day-and-night care, including:

- 24-hour skilled nursing care
- Assistance with medications, bathing and other special services
- Individual care plan managed by a personal care team (including doctors, advanced practice nurses, skilled nurses, certified nursing assistants, social workers, chaplains, volunteers and grief counselors)
- Medical equipment, supplies and medications based on individual needs
- Prepared meals and snacks
- Laundry service on-site for machine-washable clothing
- Housekeeping

## Important Questions

### Who is eligible?

Individuals of all ages receiving hospice care from Unity who are in the final stages of life and would like to receive skilled nursing care in a home-like setting or are seeking hospice respite care.

### Who may refer a patient?

Anyone. Referrals come from doctors, patients, family members, friends and clergy. A simple phone call to Unity at 920.338.1111 or 800.990.9249 can answer questions.

### What are the charges and how are they paid for?

Unity is able to offer room and board at a reasonable cost to our patients. Daily room and board are covered by a patient's private insurance, private pay and charity care. Hospice care services are covered by Medicare, Medicaid, private insurance, private pay and charity care.

### What is the difference between Unity's hospice residence and a hospital or nursing home?

Our residence is a short-term care facility that offers a home-like environment staffed with end-of-life care specialists. Hospitals provide an acute medical care setting and do not offer residential care. Nursing homes generally provide long-term skilled care.

### When can loved ones visit?

Our residence welcomes family and friends 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. The private patient rooms cater to guest visits and include a fold-out bed to accommodate overnight stays by a family member. Pet visits welcomed.
