A tribute to you — our supporters

Two thousand and seven was a milestone year for Unity. We celebrated the 30th anniversary of our organization and 5th year of providing palliative care to the community, moved our headquarters to our De Pere campus and opened the area's first facility specializing in end-of-life care—the Jack and Engrid Meng Residence. In 2007, our care programs reached 1,743 hospice and palliative patients, over 5,200 people participated in Unity's bereavement program and the community showed a positive response to having an end-of-life care facility, with increasing numbers of patients choosing the Meng Residence for their last days. We have counted each of you in our achievements throughout the years. This past year was no exception.

As we move forward in 2008, we do so believing that there are ways that we can increase access, improve care and provide more options for our families. The health care needs of the community guide us in our efforts. In 2008, we plan to increase care to underinsured and uninsured hospice patients by providing for expanded services, including pharmaceutical needs, medical equipment and supplies, as well as room and board at the Meng Residence. Additionally, we intend to continue providing care through our growing bereavement and palliative care programs, despite a lack of funds for reimbursement through insurance or private pay. Last year, \$372,000 from community donations made possible 62,000 days of patient care for individuals—your friends, family and neighbors—on our palliative program.

You will notice a new look to *Tribute* this year. This is because of the above. We know that you donate to Unity because of our programs and what they mean to so many in our community. We want to share with you how your donations have made an impact and why future contributions are necessary to maintain the same level of care for all individuals in need of hospice, palliative and bereavement support. In reducing the size of *Tribute*, we are also able to save substantially in design, printing and mailing costs, directing those dollars back to the programs you believe in and that make Unity the leading hospice and palliative care provider that it is today. Finally, we recognize that *Tribute* is, as the name implies, a tribute—not only to you, but also to those special people you have chosen to honor and memorialize throughout the year with your gifts to Unity. Their names have been included because they mean so much to you.

As you read through the pages of *Tribute*, we hope you will take pride in what we have accomplished together this past year and join us in our endeavors to move forward in 2008.

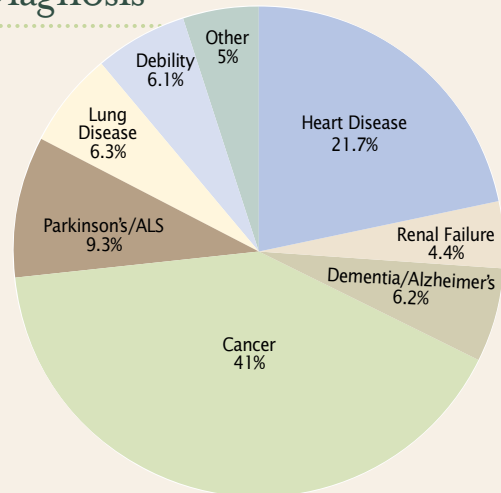

As we celebrate another year of quality care, we give a special *thank you* to those who have helped us extend our care programs to the people in Northeast Wisconsin who need hospice, palliative, bereavement and residential hospice care. **In 2007, your support helped us to ...**

- Care for 1,743 hospice and palliative patients, enabling many people to remain independent in their own homes.
- Provide 62,000 days of palliative care that were not reimbursed by patients' private insurance plans or private pay, amounting to \$372,000.

Admissions by Diagnosis



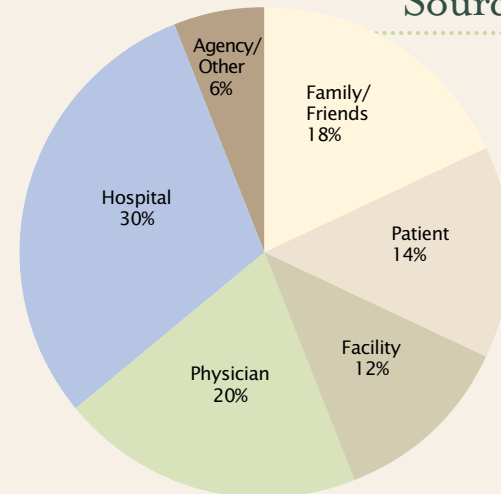
- Open the Jack and Engrid Meng Residence—the area's first hospice residence—in July of 2007. During the last six months of the year, **over 70 people chose the Residence as their home**. Patient and family comments have expressed satisfaction with the home-like environment, private rooms and amenities, and the 24-hour skilled care provided to them.



Jack and Engrid Meng Residence

- Support over 5,200 adults, teens and children through our bereavement program, a hospice-mandated program that is unfunded. Community support helped cover \$319,795 of expenses in 2007.
- Comfort 18 children who experienced the loss of a loved one through Camp Lloyd, a week-long summer camp offered in partnership with the University of Wisconsin-Green Bay to support grieving children.

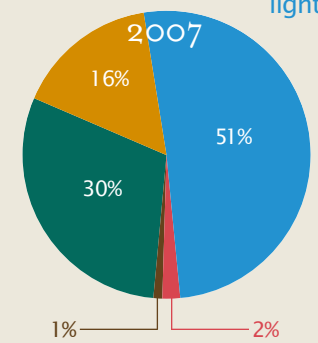

Understanding the community's desire to direct where individual contributions are used, Unity has developed a list of giving options for 2008. Please help us to fulfill our mission by supporting the following programs:



Patient Care

- **Hospice care** focuses on comfort and holistic wellbeing for those who are in the last six months of life and no longer receiving curative treatment. In 2008, Unity has pledged to **offer medication, equipment and supplies to all uninsured or underinsured patients** on our hospice program who are unable to cover these costs.
- **Palliative care** focuses on the relief of suffering and the improvement of quality of life across the spectrum of a life-limiting or serious illness and is a choice for people who may be seeking or receiving curative treatment. **Unity ensures one consistent care plan** is maintained, often enabling people to remain independent and in their own homes. Covered only by limited private insurance companies, **many Unity patients cannot cover the expenses** through private pay, and Unity is committed to caring for all patients, regardless of their ability to pay.

Bereavement

- **Loved ones of Unity patients and in the community are provided individual and group bereavement opportunities** with Unity's licensed and certified professionals and specially-trained volunteers. Bereavement programs do not have a reimbursement source, and contributions from the community help Unity to support individuals of all ages as they cope with issues of grief and loss.
- **2008 bereavement programs** include **Camp Lloyd** (summer camp for children, ages 7-13), **Special Days for Young People** (Saturday programs for all children, combining music, art and storytelling), **Navigating the Waters of Grief** (five-week adult support group) and **Men's Luncheon** (monthly opportunity for conversation and support).

Jack and Engrid Meng Residence

- **Many patients turn to the Residence for their end-of-life care:** elderly patients who live alone, young parents who do not wish to die in front of their children and young spouses who are overwhelmed with the multiple tasks of caregiving for a family and the necessity of keeping their jobs. Hospice care services are covered by Medicare, Medicaid and other funding sources. Room and board are covered by private insurance, private pay and community support. **In 2008, Unity has pledged to designate two rooms for patients in need of community support.** The daily cost for room and board in the private rooms of our Residence is \$175/day.

Unity's Memorial Gardens and CommUnity Center

Natural sites for healing, reflection and remembrance

Hospice patients at Unity's Jack and Engrid Meng Residence, caregivers, family members, staff and the community will benefit from the Memorial Gardens planned for Unity's Campus.

The six distinct garden areas, each with a unique design, include the Butterfly Garden, Children's Garden, Flower Cutting Garden, Meditation Garden, Rose Garden and Sensory Garden, complete with interactive features, ponds, fountain, pergolas, bridges, memorial bricks and benches for reflection and meditation.

Loved ones of Unity patients and the community are invited to help the gardens grow and thrive through sponsorship of memorial bricks, garden features, themed garden areas and general donations.



Complementing the Memorial Gardens will be Unity's CommUnity Center, designed as a place for families to heal and remember, Unity staff to learn and grow, and the community to join in gatherings of personal importance.
